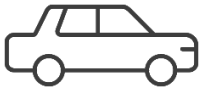




Living Science 2021-2022 Health & Safety Protocols

We are excited about school opening on September 3rd. We praise God for the size of Living Science and the approach we take to education. Because of our non-traditional facility and parent driven education approach, we are uniquely suited to weather this season of unique challenges and provide excellent, in person education.

We have created the following protocols and policies with prayerful and thoughtful intention to operate effectively with our available resources, staff, and physical space.



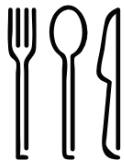
- Middle & HS students will drop off at front drive; elementary students at back of school.
- Students will proceed directly to the temperature screening station.
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- All teachers, staff, and other visitors must check in at the front door.
- Parents who wish to stay on campus may do so after checking in
- Each building will have doors designated "Entrance" or "Exit", minimizing contact.
- All travel off-campus between classes must be parent-approved & communicated to the staff.



- Temperatures less than 99.5 will receive a wrist band that they must wear for the day.
- Temperatures 99.5 or greater, we will immediately communicate with the parent.
- Temperatures 100.4 or above will not be allowed into the building until fever free for 24 hours.



- Classrooms, lab equipment, and computers will be sanitized after each class.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be located outside of the classrooms. The student bathrooms have touchless soap dispensers, water faucets, and paper towel dispensers.
- Bathrooms & high-touch areas will be wiped down frequently during the day.
- Masks are not required. They are permitted for students if required by parents. All students, staff, teachers, and parents will respect the choices made by each family.



- Students must bring their own food and drink in disposable or take-home container
- Student refrigerator and microwave are available for student use
- Food left behind will be disposed of daily; food left in the fridge disposed of on Friday.
- Students should eat outside, weather permitting, but must clean & sanitize their area.
- Students will be allowed to use the playground equipment and play areas. (Body movement is essential to effective learning)



- We ask parents to enter a covenant with Living Science.
- Parents must keep their children home if they are not feeling well or have a temperature above 100.4 & must contact the office if any immediate family tests positive for COVID-19.
- Should a positive test for a student occur, Living Science will communicate with families of students who were in direct contact in accordance with HIPAA guidelines and regulations.
- We ask parents to make their own personal health decisions for their family and respect the decisions of others within these policies during these unique and challenging times.
